

## Apollo Shine Foundation's initiative on road safety awareness

Chennai, Nov 16:

In an effort to raise awareness on road safety and protect children from road accidents, Thiru P.K. Sekar Babu, Minister for Hindu Religious & Charitable Endowments, participated in the last day of the "Helmets For Kids" campaign today. The campaign is a special initiative by the Apollo Shine Foundation, a campus health non-profit dedicated to the health and safety of children in schools and colleges. Harshad Reddy, Director, Apollo Shine Foundation and Dr Upendra Kinjawadekar, National President - Indian Academy of Pediatrics were present at the event, organized as part of Children's day celebrations.

The Foundation launched the

campaign on World Trauma Day in light of the rise in the number of road accidents and the evolving discourse on road safety and trauma-related injuries. The campaign, centred on the slogan 'No Excuse OK, Wear A Helmet', calls upon children to become aware of the protection a helmet can offer and to always wear a helmet when riding a two-wheeler.

As part of this effort, a team from the Apollo Shine Foundation visited a host of schools, gifted students with child helmets and held educative sessions to raise awareness around the cause. Poster-making contests were also organized to encourage students to get creative about themes such as road safety, protection from trauma-related head injuries

and the importance of wearing a helmet.

The 25 feet long, specially designed spacious wellness container has a diagnostic centre and a chemical toilet fitted with air conditioners and is independently powered by the on-board generator and inverter. The vehicle

is provided with canopies and chairs for patients in-waiting. "This is the largest diabetes screening camp which is being conducted for the police force and family members in Chennai," Shankar Jiwal IPS, Director General of Police said.

"With advanced diagnostic tools and expert healthcare professionals, 'Wellness on the Wheels' is the embodiment of accessible, quality care. Diabetes is creating

a great havoc to our society, we are happy to organize this diabetic health camp for our State Superheroes. In general Policemen do not have a regular time schedule. ## RCM donates medical equipment to Kanchi Kamakoti Childs Trust Hospital

Chennai, Nov 16:

The Rotary Club of Madras (RCM), through a CSR grant from Raj Petro Specialities Private Limited and Raj Charitable Foundation, donated medical equipment worth Rs. 18 lakhs to Kanchi Kamakoti CHILDs Trust Hospital today.

The 35 bed Neonatal ICU (NICU) of Kanchi Kamakoti CHILDs Trust Hospital, headed by Dr. N. Chandrasekaran, is one of the oldest NICUs in the country.

It caters to newborn babies from the city of Chennai, rest of Tamil Nadu, southern Andhra Pradesh and neighbouring states. Since this NICU is a level IV referral unit, we receive very sick newborns who require the maximum level of life support. One such condition which requires advanced life support is persistent pulmonary hypertension in newborn (PPHN) wherein the blood pressure in the lungs does not fall after birth, as expected.

As a result, the baby struggles to breathe because blood cannot pickup oxygen in the lungs. This can lead to failure of multiple organs in the body and eventually death of the baby if not treated in time. One of the modalities available to treat PPHN is Inhaled Nitric oxide (iNO). This is a gas delivered through the ventilator which causes the blood pressure in the lungs to fall and thus improves oxygen delivery to the body.
